Certificates

BI Bind a certificate to a TKDS token
CO Connect a certificate to a key ring
EX Export a certificate
GR Generate a certificate request based on the specified certificate
L Generates RACDCERT LIST
LC View information on all certificates in a certificate chain
RK Rekey (replicate) a certificate with a new key pair
RO Supersede a ticket with a new ticket and retire the old certificate
UB Unbind a certificate from a TKDS token

CKGRACF USR fields

A Approve queued command
C Copy queued command or set schedule
D Deny queued command or clear schedule

H Hold queued command
I Add another command and queue for approval or schedule action
R Edit current command and queue for approval or schedule action

RACLINK fields

A Approve pending association
C Copy current RACLINK association
D Generates RACLINK *id (userid) undefine (linked.node.user)* command
I Copy or insert RACLINK association for current user

Primary (ISPF) commands that can be used in the zSecure user interface



ACCESS – Shows access for an ID on a resource

ACL EFFECTIVE – Shows an effective access list

ACL EXPLODE – Shows exploded access list

ACL NORMAL, ASIS -Shows actual access list

ACL NOSCOPE – Deactivates display of administrative authorities as part of the access list display

ACL NOUNIVERSAL – Deactivates the UNIVERSAL option

ACL RESOLVE – Shows resolved access list

ACL SCOPE – Activates display of administrative authorities as part of the access list

ACL SORT ACCESS – Sorts access list from OWNER to NONE

ACL SORT ID – Sorts access list by ID

ACL SORT USER – Sorts access list by user (with resolve/explode)

ACL TRUST – Shows trust relations of the profile

ACL UNIVERSAL – Takes system-wide operations and users with a default connection to a universal group into consideration when building the access list

C2RIMENU - Displays the results of the authority checks for the menu options to be shown and the actions to be shown on the menus

CANCEL - Resets pending administrative changes in displays that support overtyping

CARLA, COMM - Types CARLa commands

CKNSERVE - Displays information about the zSecure Servers that are known to the zSecure Server address space identified by the ServerToken parameter on the CARLa OPTION command

CKXDEBUG - Displays CKX diagnostic information

CKXLOG – Set or view the current ticket ID and description

COLS - Shows a ruler in the top of your screen

FIELDS - Shows all fields that can be used in CARLa queries

FIND - Performs a character string search for text in a display panel

FORALL - Issues a command for all or selected profiles on a record-level display

HELP - Equivalent to the PF1 key

MESSAGES, MSG, MSGS - Shows the message library or look up a message

MODIFY - Enables or disables the ability to change values of modifiable fields

PRT, PRTLST - Creates a hardcopy of a display, written to the standard ISPF LIST data set

RACF - Opens the RACF ISPF panels

RA.G – Same as entering ID or pattern into the group ID selection field in the RA.G selection panel, and entering the COMPLEX name to which the current row belongs

RA.U – Same as copy and paste of the ID or pattern into the user ID selection field in the RA.U selection panel, and entering the COMPLEX name to which the current row belongs

REFRESH - Resets changes in modified fields

RESET - Removes all pending updates from display panels and cancel pending commands

RESULTS - Shows resulting files from last query

RFIND - Repeats the previous FIND command from the current cursor position

SET - An alternative way to change some options on the Setup - View and Setup - Confirm display panels

SETUP - Invokes the SETUP application

SORT - SORT *field* [A,D] *field* [A,D]....

STARTPAN - Specifies the panel that opens when zSecure starts

SYSPREV - Browses the SYSPRINT message file of a recursive query

TEMPLATE - Shows the contents of the RACF database templates

X – Find all records in the table that match the search argument and exclude those from the display

XF – Exclude all records from the display and then find and include all records that match the search arguments
